ATHLETIC COMMITMENT SHEET



As a Coppell ISD student/athlete I understand that:

1. It is a **privilege**, not a right, to participate in athletics. Coaches retain the right to revoke the privilege when I am not in compliance with policies, procedures, and expectations.
2. I will be held to a higher standard of expectations than other students not participating in athletics. This includes dress, grooming, and behavior.
3. I represent Coppell Athletics at all times, including in the classroom and away from school. Therefore my coaches will expect exemplary conduct at all times.
4. UIL rules state that I must have passing grades in **all** classes **every** six weeks to remain eligible to participate on a team.
5. I must be present at least one-half the school day to participate in a contest unless approved by my principal.
6. I must participate in at least one sport **each semester**. Trying out for a team is not the same as participating. **Commitment to athletics is a yearlong obligation.**
7. When I am not in season, I will be in the offseason/track lifting and running program.
8. There will be periods of times that workouts will start before school and finish after school.
9. If I miss practice, my playing time will be affected.
10. Equal playing time is not guaranteed.
11. Participation for my school is a priority over non-school events.
